Terrorism

R v MA In this case Mary Tmaira successfully represented a young man accused of being part of the Blackburn Resistance. MA was the only defendant to be wholly acquitted of all charges.

R v KL In this case Mary Tmaira successfully represented a man accused of possessing items for the production of improvised explosive devices.

Financial Crime

R v HS In this case Mary Tmaira successfully represented an elderly gentleman accused of defrauding the NHS of hundreds of thousands of pounds.

R v SB Mary Tmaira successfully represented this defendant who was charged with conspiracy to defraud over £80 million. This was part of a large and complex Very High Cost Case.

R v KM Mary Tmaira successfully represented this defendant who was charged with conspiracy to defraud over £80 million. This was part of a large and complex Very High Cost Case.

R v DR Mary Tmaira acted as junior counsel in this large scale conspiracy to defraud the DVLA. This was a Very High Cost Case.

R v MM Mary Tmaira acted as junior counsel in this Very High Cost Case. It involved a large scale fraud against the NHS.

R v HC Mary Tmaira successfully represented this defendant in relation to a Very High Cost Case conspiracy to defraud. This case involved a large scale crash for cash operation.

R v GR In this case Mary Tmaira successfully represented a defendant charged with

conspiracy to launder the proceeds of large scale supply of class A drugs.

R v MK

Mary Tmaira successfully represented a defendant in relation to a large scale conspiracy to launder the proceeds of crime. The defendant was linked to a money services bureau that was 'cleaning' the proceeds of large scale drug dealing.

R v AA

In this case Mary Tmaira acted as junior counsel for a defendant accused of conspiring to launder millions of pounds of cash.

Murder

R v A

In this case Mary Tmaira successfully represented a young boy charged with murder at the Old Bailey. The defendant was part of a large gang of youths who attacked and stabbed a boy from a rival gang.

R v R

In this case Mary Tmaira successfully represented a youth charged with murder at the Central Criminal Court. The victim was stabbed after being lured to the scene of the murder following a falling out over a girlfriend.

R v WS

Mary Tmaira successfully represented this defendant who was charged with murder following a drunken brawl with a fellow Polish national. This case attracted media attention after a body was discovered buried in a garden in North London. This case was dealt with at the Old Bailey.

R v JT

Mary Tmaira successfully represented this defendant who was accused of assisting his brothers following a triple murder in Bishops Stortford. The victims in this case were mowed down using a semi automatic weapon following a disagreement over drugs.

General Crime

R v DL

In this case Mary Tmaira successfully represented a defendant accused of taking part in an armed robbery.

R v DB

In this case Mary Tmaira successfully represented a defendant charged with an historical rape of a member of the Salvation Army. The defendant was also charged and acquitted of sexual offences against a child.

R v DO

Mary Tmaira successfully represented this elderly defendant accused of historic rape.

R v GC

Mary Tmaira successfully represented this defendant in relation to a large scale conspiracy to supply drugs.
