<b>R v KF &amp; others</b>	Conspiracy to commit burglary in the Northampton area.

**R v DW, MR & others** Sham marriages and breach of immigration laws  
**R v JA** Immigration deception/ breach of immigration laws.  
**R v RB** Blackmail causing the complainant to commit suicide.
